Communication and language

This term we will be using stories and non-fiction books to learn about the superheroes that help us. They will be looking at how books can help us learn new vocabulary.

The children will also be discussing who their superheroes are and what they do to help them and keep them safe. They will also have the opportunity to ask questions to our superhero visitors!

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

The children will be learning about how to look after themselves and how to keep themselves safe. By focusing on superheroes the children will also learn about what to do in an emergency and who they can call when they need help. We will also be looking at the importance of looking after our teeth and maintaining good oral health.

Physical Development

This term the children will start a new focus in PE. We will start to incorporate ball skills into our movements looking at the different ways we can move or throw balls. This will form part of developing the children's overall body strength.

Children will also continue to develop their fine motor skills with our daily dough disco and mini mover sessions.

Literacy

This term we move on to looking at digraphs in phonics – when two letters together make 1 sound. (ch, sh, thh, ng, ai, ee, igh, oa, oo,) We will also be recapping the tricky words learned last term. In our writing groups the children will be writing lists, creating posters and writing up their findings from the scientific experiments.

Maths

This term the children will continue to develop their maths skills and also the composition of numbers. Children will start to learn their number bonds to 10. They will also look at the properties of 3D shapes and how to make more complex repeating patterns.

Understanding of the World

The children will be looking at different occupations this term and how other people help us. We will also be joining in with the school's Big Science Event. The children will have the opportunity to carry out their own scientific investigations linked to our superhero topic.

Expressive Arts and Design

The children will be encouraged to try new artistic techniques this term as they develop their skills in this area. They will have opportunities to revisit the songs and rhymes learned last term and use instruments to perform them to each other.
