

As **readers**, we are going to reading our new class novel 'Esio Trot' by Roald Dahl as well as developing our reading comprehension skills when exploring different text types such as our class novel.

As **authors**, we are going to be looking at a range of texts with an independent write every Friday.

As **historians**, we are going to be learning about The First Aeroplane flight. We will be looking at when the first aeroplane flight took place and know who the Wright brothers were and some key facts about them. We will be ordering key events in the Wright brothers' lives. We will also learn about the flight of the first power driven aeroplane and have some understanding about how a plane flies through experimenting.

In **computing**, we will be focusing on programming and investigating and exploring how to move a robot.

As **musicians**, we are going to be learning the friendship song.

As **mathematicians**, we are going to be developing our mastery approach to math's with a focus on:

Year 1 Number and Geometry:

- Multiplication and Division
- Fractions
- Position and Direction

Year 2 Number and measurement:

- Fractions
- Time

As **scientists**, we will be learning about plants and living things.

We will be Identifying, naming and describing a variety of common wild and garden plants, including deciduous and evergreen trees and their structures.

We will also be Explore and compare the differences between things that are living, dead and things that have never been alive along with different habitats and food chains.
