As readers, we are going to be reading The 1000 Year old Boy by Ross Welford as our class book. In Guided Reading, the class will read a variety of books in groups. To support our Writing, we will focus on different forms of poetry, as well as Nonfiction and fiction books.

As **authors**, we are going to be writing a recount, a mystery story and later looking at different styles of poetry, using some of the great classics as a starting point. Those children who want to take on leadership roles will also be writing speeches to persuade us that they are the best person for the job!

As **historians** we are going to be learning about life in the Stone Age and the transitions that happened as we moved to the Iron Age.
