

As **readers**, we will be reading The Strangeworlds Travel Agency by L.D Lapinski, which will take us to interesting places! We will also be reading non-fiction texts that are persuasive in nature. Our daily reading comprehension will be taken from a series of different texts, both fiction and non-fiction as well as poetry.

As **authors**, Spelling and grammar will be taught from the National Curriculum and will help us to develop as independent writers. We will be writing persuasive speeches as well as narratives with a focus on characterization and atmosphere.

As **linguists**, we will continue learning French and thinking about French foods and the specialities of France. How to ask for something in a restaurant and how to respond to general questions.

In **computing**, this term, children will look at finding and creating variables in a game. We will also cover areas of on-line safety and basic word processing skills.

In **RE**,
Year 5 will be learning about How can Brahman be everywhere and in everything? (Y5) **Hinduism**
Year 6 will learn about **Humanism** and What does it mean to be a Humanist?

As **mathematicians**, we are going to be developing our mastery approach to Maths with a focus on:

- Place value
- All four operations
- Percentages and decimals

As **scientists**, we will be investigating Forces and the wonders of Space.

As **Artists** we will investigate how artists use their creativity to make statements about their beliefs. These may be linked to social injustice, the environment or any other area that they feel strongly about. The children will consider their own thoughts and create posters that represent their ideas. Whilst in **DT** we will look at different ways to combine different fabrics and materials.

As **Historians** we will be learning about the Anglo Saxons and the Vikings as we consider the question of how the power struggled changed over this period.

In **Geography**, we will be learning about world geography and in particular what is it like to live in different parts of the world.
